Achievement and Progress recorded in Directorate of IT for preparation of Message of the Hon'ble Governor of Tripura on the occasion of Republic Day, 2021

As per Digital India Roadmap, several initiatives have been undertaken by the Directorate of Information Technology, Govt of Tripura, to improve the delivery of public services and simplify the process of accessing them through digital infrastructure.

2. Digital Connectivity status across the State:

To provide connectivity for Government functioning, the **SWAN** (State Wide Area Network) has been extended to all the DMs, SDMs and BDOs offices through 2/4/8/10/100/1000 Mbps leased lines. Total 84 SWAN Point of Presences (PoP) have been setup to connect SHQ, all DHQs, all SDHQs, all BHQs and TTAADC HQ. Under **Horizontal Extension of SWAN** (HSWAN) project about 400 offices were connected through RF (Radio Frequency), OFC (Optical fiber cable) and Ethernet Technology. 22 offices have been connected in last one year.

3. Tripura State Data Centre (TSDC): TSDC is providing data centre services/cloud service to different Departments/Organizations/Offices for hosting, running and storing their applications, etc. for delivering services to citizens. About, 110 websites and 66 applications are hosted in TSDC. Work is in progress to shift TSDC to new Data Center at IT Bhawan.

4. Digital Transformation of Government Services across the State:

Digital Seva (eDistrict) Project: Through Digital Seva, Citizens make online application and receive digital signed certificate/ output online. Currently, 30 services are operational under eDistrict online platform. These services are integrated with Digital Signature (DSC), SMS gateway, email gateway, payment gateway, CSC, CSC wallet, UMANG, DigiLocker etc. In last one year 6 more services were onboarded. Work is in progress to on-board more services.

eOffice: -To transform the functioning of the Government into a more efficient mode, the e-Office was introduced. 14 Departments/Organization/Offices have implemented eOffice in the State using the File Tracking System/ File Management System modules as on date. 4 Departments/Organisations/Offices were onboarded in last one year.

Common Service Centres (CSCs): There are 1738 registered CSCs spread across all the 8 districts of Tripura and 1060 CSCs covered under GP/VC as on date. CSCs are managed by VLE (Village Level Entrepreneurs). Through CSCs various B2C services are made available online includes like eDistrict services, Banking Service, Insurance, Utility Bills payment etc.

Software and Application Development: More than 76 websites and 18 applications of various Department/Organisation of the State have been developed as on date as a tool to reach out to the citizens. More numbers of development of websites and application are also in progress.

5. New Initiatives: -

Mukhyamantri Yuba Yogayog Yojana: - Under this scheme a grant of Rs 5000/- each is being provided to final year college students for purchase of Smartphone to empower them digitally and help them leverage the advantages of an interconnected world. Total 8893 final year college students of 38 Colleges/Institutes/Tripura University applied for the scheme during the academic year 2019-20. Out of 8893 applicants, 7286 applications have been approved in the National Scholarship Portal. Payment has been made to 7286 students as on date.

IT/ITeS Startup Schemes: -The Government through this initiative aims to empower Startups to grow through innovation and design. To meet the objectives of this initiative, the State issued Gazette Notification on IT Startup Scheme, 2019. A Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) was published in the websites for disbursement of Incentive under IT/ITeS START-UP SCHEME, 2019. Webinar has been conducted at regular interval with the students of NIT, TIT, ICFAI University along with local entrepreneurs and NASSCOM. With this Plan, the Government hopes to accelerate spreading of the Startup movement.

Scheme Discovery Mobile App: A Mobile App is being developed for easy discovery of any Schemes by the citizen. This App will help the citizen to find out their eligibility in various Government schemes.
