Meeting Notice

A meeting was held on 26th Aug 2016 under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary, Govt. of Tripura on implementation of online payment Gateway System, so that citizen can make e-payment of various utility bills, challans, taxes etc to the respective Government Departments/ Organisations. In this regard, two proposals have been received on e-Services offered by the State Bank of India (SBI) and United Bank of India (UBI) for Government Receipts & Payment solutions. Brief information on the SBI and UBI proposals is attached.

In the above meeting, the Chief Secretary had decided that online payment gateway platform would be initially integrated with applications of Transport (Road tax, Registration fee), Revenue (Property registration – Stamp Duty and Registration fees), Labour, Health (MRI, ICU, CT scan), Factories & Boilers (Inspection fees).

To carry the above decision, a meeting is scheduled to be held on 27th Sep 2016 at 4.00 PM in the Conference Hall No-II, Secretariat Building, Capital Complex, in which SBI and UBI will make a presentation on their proposal.

All the addressees may make it convenient to attend along with their nodal IT officers / persons handling the application.

SBI proposal:

Offered two solutions, one "Cash Management Product: for payment and other "SBI e-Pay" for receipt.

It was informed that SBI e-Pay has entered into a MoU with 41 leading Banks across the country for facilitating their retail and corporate internet banking customers to participate in the e-commerce activities and paying their dues to Govt., PSUs, etc. SBI e-Pay also offer payment through cards on VISA, Mastercard, AMEX, Rupay platform, IMPS, Mobile wallet such as CSC Wallet, Paypal. SBI also shared a MoU format but service processing fees for different online transaction mode not indicated.

UBI proposal:

Offered few solutions namely: Centralized Payment Hub (CPH) Public Financial Management System (PFMS), Global Cash Management Service (GCMS) for payment and National Automated Clearing House (NACH), offline mode, UBI net banking, UBI Wallet, payment gateway mode for all customer powered by channel partner for receipt.

UBI has not shared MoU format but indicated service processing fees for different online transaction mode.
